

Cookies Policy UrHome Group

1. What are cookies?

"Cookies" are small software tags that are stored on your computer through the browser, retaining only information related to your preferences and not including your personal data.

2. What are cookies used for?

Cookies are used to help determine the usefulness, interest, and number of uses of websites, allowing for faster and more efficient navigation, eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information.

3. What types of cookies do we use?

There are two groups of cookies that can be used:

Permanent cookies - These are cookies that are stored at the browser level on your access devices (PC, mobile, and tablet) and are used whenever you visit one of our websites. They are generally used to tailor navigation to the user's interests, allowing us to provide a more personalized service.

Session cookies - These are temporary cookies that remain in your browser's cookie file until you leave the website. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyze web traffic patterns, enabling us to identify issues and provide a better browsing experience.

4. How long are cookies stored on my device?

Two types of cookies can be stored:

Session cookies: These are automatically deleted when you close your browser.

Persistent cookies: These remain on your computer until they are deleted or expire. Persistent cookies can retain your user preferences to make future navigation easier and more relevant.

5. Where are your information stored and processed?

We may transfer and store the information we collect about you outside your country of origin. It may be processed by our in-house team or by thirdparty companies providing services to UrHome Portugal. When we do so, we ensure that the information is secure and properly protected. These measures are based on adequacy decisions or the implementation of appropriate safeguards (e.g., standard contractual clauses).

6. How can I change my cookie preferences?

You can change your cookie preferences through the cookie settings.

7. Cookie Type and Purpose

7.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies These allow you to navigate the website and use its applications, as well as access secure areas of the website. Without these cookies, the requested services cannot be provided.

7.2. Analytical Cookies These are used anonymously for the purpose of creating and analyzing statistics to improve the website's functioning.

7.3. Functionality Cookies

These store user preferences regarding site usage so that you do not need to reconfigure the site each time you visit.

7.4. Third-Party Cookies

These measure the success of applications and the effectiveness of third-party advertising. They can also be used to personalize a widget with user data.

7.5. Advertising Cookies

These target advertising based on each user's interests, and also limit the number of times an ad is shown, helping to measure the effectiveness of advertising and the success of website organization.

7.6. Technical cookies

This website only uses cookies that allow its proper functioning and the provision of the services offered on it, and, if applicable, proprietary cookies with the sole purpose of measuring its audience, which are therefore exempt from consent. Therefore, according to Article 22 of the Information Society Services Act, your consent is not required for their installation.
